Merge Author ID

- Scopus **automatically generates Scopus Author Identifiers** and links to your previous work can sometimes pose **problems** for analysis of citation metrics on your publications **if they are spread over several different identifiers.**
- Each author identifier **will not give the complete picture of your body of work.**
- If your publications in Scopus are spread over several different Scopus Author IDs, you can use the **'Request to merge authors' form.**

To determine which author names should be grouped together under a single identifier number, the Scopus Author Identifier uses an algorithm that matches author names based on their affiliation, address, subject area, source title, dates of publication, citations, and co-authors. Documents with insufficient data may not be matched, this can lead to more than one entry in the results list for the same author. 






